INTRODUCTION

An increasing number of questions from members about the contents of *New York Irish History* has indicated the need for an index to the Roundtable's journal.

In the index provided below, for published articles there are author, title, and subject entries. Reviews of books, exhibitions, and/or films are shown in italics, and have author, title, and reviewer entries.

Books listed in the journal, but not reviewed, have no entries. Columns without authors, bulletin boards, letters, editorials, and illustrations have not been indexed.

Initial articles like "A" and "The" have been dropped. Periods have been dropped from religious abbreviations, such as "SJ" and "RSM." Where possible, "New York City" and similar names are abbreviated, e.g., "NYC" and "NYPD."
